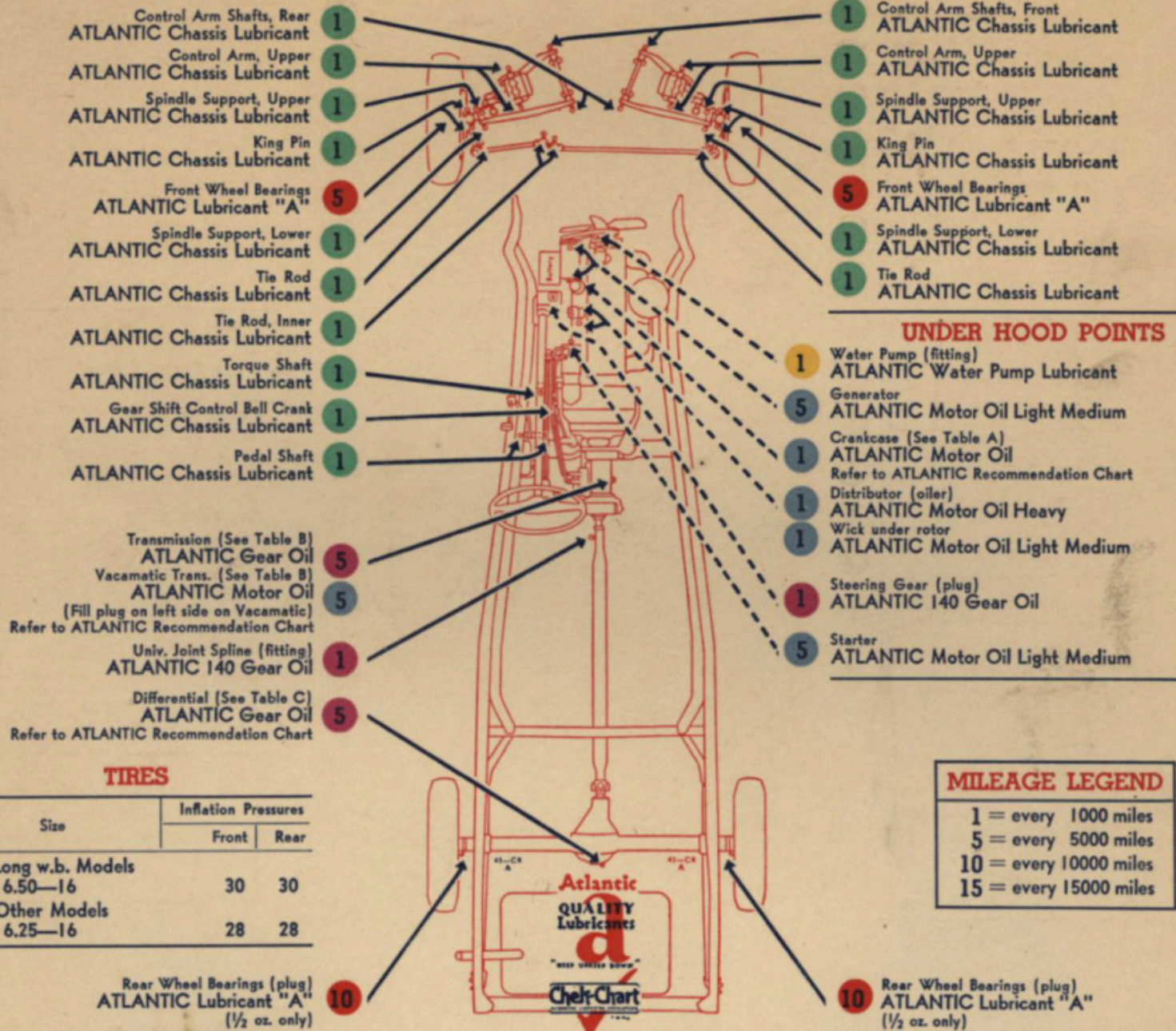

### NOTES

- STARTING SERIAL No.:** C-34 (Royal) 70001001, (Windsor) 70501001. On right front door hinge pillar post.
- SHOCK ABSORBERS—**Front and rear; also transverse strut on long wheel base models. Monroe, telescoping type. See General Instructions.
- REAR SPRINGS—**Metal covered. Lubricate if necessary with ATLANTIC CHASSIS LUBRICANT through holes in covers, using special tool.
- AIR CLEANER—**AC heavy duty, ATLANTIC MOTOR OIL EXTRA HEAVY above 32 deg.; ATLANTIC MOTOR OIL LIGHT MEDIUM below 32 deg. Oil Filler Cap, ATLANTIC MOTOR OIL EXTRA HEAVY. See General Instructions.
- FLUID DRIVE (optional)—**Drain and refill with ATLANTIC MOTOR OIL LIGHT.
- UNIVERSAL JOINTS—**Packed at assembly. Disassemble, clean and relubricate with ATLANTIC LUBRICANT "A". See General Instructions. (3 joints used on long wheel base models.)
- PROPELLER SHAFT BEARING (Long wheel base models)—**Lubricate with ATLANTIC LUBRICANT "A" through fitting.
- REMOTE CONTROL SHIFT ROD—**Apply a thin coat of ATLANTIC WATER PUMP LUBRICANT on grooved lower end. Reached from under hood.
- OIL CAN POINTS—**Under Hood—Throttle Linkage, etc., ATLANTIC MOTOR OIL LIGHT MEDIUM. DO NOT OIL AUTOMATIC CHOKE LINKAGE.
- POINTS REQUIRING NO LUBRICATION—**Fan, Clutch Release Bearing, Rear Spring Front Bolts, Spring Shackles.
